Air quality response

What a summer we had! As someone said yesterday, January was a very tough year. Here at school we are conscious that large number of our families experienced direct or indirect impact of the various critical environmental challenges in our region, and therefore were not able to fully 'recharge' for the new year. Teachers are keen to hear from you if there are individual circumstances that may be helpful to know about your child's experience.

Thankfully, some of the challenges are subsiding and we have not had days of extreme temperatures. Be assured, our Directorate and our school take every measure to apply sound decision-making based on local weather conditions each day, and the level of relative vulnerabilities of staff and students.

Our buildings did not sustain any major damage over the season but the challenge of maintaining our grounds in the extreme conditions has added an extra load on the amazing Bruno. I'm not sure how he does it all!

Updates and Upgrades

A stunning wooden outdoor stage has been installed in the Montessori outdoor area – the outcome of very successful fundraising by our parent group. It's a marvellous addition. A new concrete path encircling two large elms has been added in the preschool playground – another improvement to that very pretty play space.

Teaching and Learning

The 2020 – 2024 Strategic Plan for our school has two priorities: to improve numeracy outcomes, and to improve writing. These two areas were identified during last year's review. To assist our focus, teaching staff spent a day prior to school commencing with a facilitator from Corwin Education on Visible Learning. Our staff are also engaging in year long intensive Early Years Literacy program. These are both quality programs designed to add even more skill and expertise to our teaching. You'll hear more about them both as the year progresses.

Think before you park...and keep our kids safe!

With school now back for the year we are encouraging all parents to make parking safety a priority!

This means:

- keep clear of 'no stopping' and 'no parking' zones
- don't park in bus zones, on school crossings, across footpaths or driveways; and
- don't double (or triple) park!

Remember - it's okay to park a little further away from the school and walk the rest of the way!

Consider - having a pre-determined meeting spot agreed with your kids. That way if you are a little late, they know where to wait.

Think - visibility around schools and if your car may be blocking the view of crossings for other motorists. Also be mindful when entering or leaving parking spots – look twice!

Be kind - to other road users and pedestrians and also if you see any parking officers in the area – they are doing their job and working to keep our kids safe!

Information on Quickweb Payments via our School Web Page

Some parents have had troubles accessing Quickweb Payments. If this happens try visiting the Yarralumla Primary school website via a search engine, then clicking on the payments tab then clicking on the Quickweb link from there.

Yarralumla Primary School has an online payment option, using a Westpac service called Quickweb.

You can go to our school website: <http://www.yarralumlaps.act.edu.au/payment> and make a payment to the school's bank account. There will be a link that will redirect you to our Westpac Quickweb site. Payments can be made using a credit/debit card, for any school event, or financial contribution.

The information you complete on the form will enable us to accurately identify the funds and the purpose. The terminology used is listed below:

Family key: your family's identifier, first five letters of your last name and the first letter of your first name.

Student key: usually the first five letters of the students last name and first letter of his/her first name.

Fee Codes: a unique identifier of the event you are depositing funds for. This will be found on the correspondence sent home with your student.

The Quickweb payment facility will assist us to accurately identify the sender and the correct ledger for the funds to be receipted against. Receipts for payments can be issued via Westpac Quickweb, but if you require a gift deductible receipt, i.e. payments to a Library Fund, you will need to contact the school.

HELPFUL INFORMATION FOR PARENTS AND CARERS

Office Hours

Our Front Office is staffed from 8.30am – 3.30pm each day. Outside these hours, and if for any other reason the office is not staffed, an answering machine service will be operating and we will return your call as soon as possible.

Anything different happening at home

We encourage you to advise the class teacher of any changes in your child's home routine e.g. birth of a new sibling or a temporary or permanent change in family situation.

School Hours

School commences at 9.00am and concludes at 3.00pm with breaks for lunch break from 11.00 – 11.50am and recess 1.30 – 2.00pm. If your child is late they need to enter the school via the front office and sign-in.

Before School

Children stay outside before school and are not to go into classrooms as teachers need this time to prepare for the day's lessons and have meetings organised. Playground supervision commences at 8.30am. Supervision is only around the Main Building and Cola. Students are not permitted down on the junior equipment as there is no supervision.

To ensure the safety and welfare of all students, it is important that children do not arrive at school before 8.30am.

Pick-up Arrangements

If your child is to be collected from school during the day or taken home early, you must sign them out at the front office prior to collecting them from class. This is for the security and safety of your child. If your child is going to be picked up by someone you have not listed as a contact please advise the school either in writing, email or by phone. Your child will not be released if we are unable to verify this.

Absences

If your child is absent from school due to sickness or other family obligations, it is a legal requirement that you send a note explaining the

absence to the class teacher upon their return. A phone call to the front office on the day is also appreciated. You can also notify the school of your child's absence via email to the Front Office or class teacher.

Infection and Illnesses

Should your child contract an infection/communicable illness, please notify the office staff. There are certain periods of exclusion that apply to some infections. Please do not hesitate to contact the front office should you need further information. Some highly contagious childhood illnesses have a mandatory exclusion period – details of these can be located on the Directorate's website. For example, more common illness and infections such as vomiting and diarrhoea have an exclusion period of 24 hours after symptoms cease. Please do not hesitate to contact the school should you be unsure whether your child should be excluded from school for any reason.

Children's Medications

It is a Directorate policy requirement that written directions from a doctor and written permission from parents/carers must be provided before school staff may administer medication. This applies to any type of medication.

Communication

Email is Yarralumla School's preferred method of communication. The school will email home the newsletter, excursion notification, all important correspondence including student reports. Stay connected and informed through our school newsletter which is emailed out fortnightly on a Thursday. Always ensure the school has your correct email address.

Payments to the School

When sending in any cash payments to the school, please ensure that the student's name, class is written on the outside of the envelope and the completed signed permission note is placed inside the envelope with payment. This will ensure that you receive the correct receipt from the school when required.

Newsletter

The newsletter is published fortnightly and includes information about what is currently happening at the school and a list of dates for events. The newsletter is distributed electronically.

Food

Your child will need food for recess, lunchtime and fruit break. Food should be placed in an easily opened lunch box which will be kept in your child's bag. It is useful to have a frozen drink in the lunch box as this provides cooling for the lunch, especially in summer. Your child will also need a drink bottle as students become very thirsty during the day. We encourage children to drink water.

School Uniform

The wearing of school uniform is required at Yarralumla Primary. Exemptions can be granted by the principal in extenuating circumstances. However, the wearing of school uniform readily identifies our students in the community, especially when they are representing their school, and eliminates clothing competitiveness between students. All children are encouraged to wear an appropriate sun smart hat when playing outside. Children not wearing hats are required to stay/play in a designated shaded area of the school. A number of options are available to assist parents/carers who may be experiencing financial difficulties to obtain items of uniform for their children. Please do not hesitate to contact the principal for more information.

Sun Hats and Keeping Safe at All Times

Yarralumla Primary school recommends that children wear broad brimmed sun hats for Terms 1 and 4. Hats are not required to be worn in Terms 2 and 3. We ask all families to be aware and take extra care regarding safety for your child/ren wearing any earrings other than studs, necklaces, jewellery, clothing or hats which have long cords that could possibly get caught on equipment. At YPS we support the safety of all children at school.

Volunteers and Visitors

All visitors, classroom helpers, and volunteers must come to the front office to sign in. This is for safety and security reasons so that we know exactly who is in the building.

Labelling and Lost property

Please make sure that all items of clothing (especially hats and jumpers) and other belongings (drink bottle, lunch box, school bag) are clearly labelled with your child's name and class.

If you find your child is missing clothing items please check in the classroom and in lost property.

Mobile Phones and all Electronic Equipment

All mobile phones and electronic equipment brought to school must be left at the front office in the morning. Phones and any electronic equipment can be collected at 3pm. Thank you for your assistance with this matter.

Bikes and Scooters

Bikes & scooters are to be left locked at the bike & scooter racks. The school does not accept responsibility for lost or stolen bikes or scooters. By law, a helmet must be worn while riding.

Dogs in the Playground

From time to time we have 'visiting' dogs in the playground. ACT schools are 'dog free' zones, because many children (and staff) are scared of dogs and they can present as a risk to safety. Please assist us by ensuring that your family pet remains at home. This applies also to dogs on leads.



The 2020 Show Pre-Purchased Ticket includes free travel on bus and light rail adding to the affordability of the Show for individuals and for families.


The 1,2,3 of Medical Conditions, Medication and Treatment Plans

The ACT Education and Training Directorate guidelines regarding Medical Conditions, Treatment Plans and the administration of all medication to students must be closely followed. Here is a simple rule of thumb to go by to ensure that we are able to assist your child in the best way we can should they become ill or need emergency care while at school. At the beginning of each school year the Directorate requires parents/carers to complete a Known Medical Condition Response Plan for each child. Any specialised, individual or temporary medical requirements must be accompanied by additional medical treatment plans.

1. ANAPHYLAXIS, ASTHMA, DIABETES, EPILEPSY



2. Occasional Migraine, Headache, Hay fever, Allergies etc



3. Temporary Medication for Seasonal colds/flu/Allergies, Antibiotic, Pain relief etc



The care of your children is important to us. Due to the close contact of children in school settings, many ailments have a required exclusion period as they may be contagious. Some of these are vomiting and diarrhoea, conjunctivitis, chicken pox, impetigo, wring worm, head lice and flu. Please check with front office staff for any exclusion periods.
