### **Upcoming hazardous materials work at Yarralumla Primary**

Dear Parents and Carers,

I'm writing to let you know about upcoming improvements to our school buildings. These works will include removing lead paint and asbestos containing materials and will continue throughout the summer holidays.

This weekend (Saturday 4 and Sunday 5 December), experienced contractors are scheduled to remove older windows in the Year 3/4 classroom (maestro Stefano), located across the corridor from the front office. The removals will be complete by Monday morning, and the classroom will be closed for the remainder of term 4, with students moved to the classroom in the corridor leading to the hall.

There will be a fence erected outside of the classroom to protect students from the construction zone. There will still be safe access to the boy's toilet next to that classroom.

During the summer holidays we will continue to remove and remediate hazardous materials across the school site.

Contractors will replace windows in several rooms in the Gambarri Centre, including a toilet block, staff room, music room and the larger classroom. Windows will also be replaced in the toilets next to the 3/4 classroom. Upgrades to the art room will continue.

In line with the Directorate's sustainability goals, the new windows will be double glazed which will improve the thermal comfort of students and staff and reduce the school's carbon emissions.

All works are scheduled to be complete by the time students return in 2022.
